

ADSi's mobile dispatch solution, MDTForce, works with our CADForce CAD software to deliver critical dispatch information to units on the street seamlessly, swiftly, and silently. Virtually instantaneous data transmission at the click of a mouse or the touch of a button on the dispatch console gets the data where it needs to be, in the hands of responders, and radio traffic is reduced dramatically.

Users in the field will have easy access to a host of information via ADSi interfaces to NCIC, NLETS, CJIS, as well as the local warrant system. Additional information, including floor plans, area maps, and ADSi's WriteForce mobile reporting system can be accessed from within MDTForce. And with user-defined function keys, fewer steps are needed to obtain actual data.

WriteForce Mobile Reporting


Time on the street is a valuable commodity, and ADSi's WriteForce Mobile Reporting system is a critical time-saver. Users can complete reports on the scene, or at another location but still "on the road," increasing visibility for the department and increasing "at the ready" status for more available units. Completed reports can be uploaded to the department's DataForce Web Records Management System by immediate transmission, delayed transmission via wireless hotspots, or manually transferred via a portable data storage device.



Mobile MapForce

Mobile MapForce places the map at the point of need, in the hands of field personnel, with the following functionality:

- Program navigation is the same as the in-house version of MapForce
- Real-time interface with MDTForce in accepting and plotting the dispatch location received from CADForce
- Unit location tracking when used with GPS/AVL
- Identify & locate specific streets/addresses
- Identify & locate latitude/longitude positions
- Routing to incident locations – automatically – when dispatched
- Overview of all vehicle and incident locations for field supervisors
- Maps reside on the MDT to save bandwidth
- Display by address, active incidents, or user-defined points of interest
- Used with ADSi AVL system, location of units is displayed
- Previously defined hazards can be displayed on the map



Handheld Compatibility

Continuing developments allow for more and more technology to be placed, literally, in the hands of public safety professionals. ADSi's Mobile Data Solutions work well within the Windows Mobile OS (v.5 or later), and with a device* equipped with a mag-stripe/barcode scanner, information can be "at the fingertips" of the professional on the street.
